OBJECTIVE

The Federal Occupational Health (FOH) Organizational Development and Leadership (ODL) team engaged LinkVisum to conduct an assessment across the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Office of the Assistant Secretary for Health (OASH) to better understand the process and organizational needs and identify opportunities for improvement.

The LinkVisum team leveraged its proprietary tools and depth of experience to lead focus groups and a series of interviews with senior leaders to gain insight into the organization's challenges and propose a plan of action to address them. As part of the OASH Process Improvement Project, LinkVisum, under the direction of FOH, conducted an organizational assessment of the current state environment of OASH to determine if the following focus areas adequately supported the organization's goals: strategy and performance, organizational structure and workload, roles and responsibilities, processes and tools, and stakeholder objectives. The analysis took into consideration stakeholder input from the high-level assessment and process improvement efforts, and data collected regarding strategy, current staffing, and future initiatives.
